Pavilion Stage	\$1,000/day	60'x60'	Multiple Formats; May be used for seated reception: 200	Includes men's and women's backstage restrooms, green room, and stage electricity.
North Lawn	\$50/hour	150'x200'	Lawn Standing Room: 3,000	Staked tents not permitted, weight limit applies.
South Lawn	\$50/hour	300'x200'	Lawn Standing Room: 6,000	Staked tents not permitted, weight limit applies.
East Lawn	\$50/hour	200'x230'	Lawn Standing Room: 5,000	Staked tents permitted with location approval.
Bosque	\$50/hour	170'x125'	Seating: 300	Crushed stone gravel with umbrellas, 75 tables, 300 chairs remain in place.

Item/Service	Fee	Description		
Pavilion Sound	\$500/day	Professional-grade sound and audio system for use with pavilion rental only.		
Pavilion Lighting	\$500/day	Professional-grade lighting system for use with pavilion rental only.		
Pavilion Video Screens	\$200/day	Access to (2) 16'x9' LED screens on stage during event. Must include 25% Columbus Commons artwork. If artwork is submitted improperly, requiring additional staff troubleshooting the fee may be charged.		
Pavilion Stage Extensions	Varies	Multiple layout options available to increase stage size & access. Labor & equipment estimate can be provided upon request.		
Mobile Sound System	\$200/day	Available to use throughout park to amplify sound. Includes setup & teardown. 2 sound engineers are required with mobile sound system rental.		
Mobile Sound System Risers	\$100/day	16'x8'x2' portable staging. Includes setup & teardown with rental of mobile sound system.		
Pavilion Security	\$25/hour	Minimum of 2 officers required during events while pavilion is in use. 3 hour minimum.		
Production Manager	\$50/hour	Required with pavilion rental. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges may apply.		
Stage Manager	\$34/hour	Required for events with multiple acts or national acts onstage. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges may apply.		
Production Assistant	\$22/hour	May be required with pavilion rental. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges may apply.		
Sound Engineer	\$34/hour	Required with rental of pavilion sound. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges apply.		
Lighting Engineer	\$34/hour	Required with rental of pavilion lights. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges apply.		
Production Staff	\$34/hour	As needed, based on programming. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges apply.		
Rigging & Lift Operation	\$39/hour	As needed with pavilion rental, based on programming. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges apply.		
Pavilion & North Lawn Maintenance	\$32/hour	Required with pavilion rental. 4 hour minimum. Provides housekeeping of backstage restrooms & maintains trash in North Lawn.		
Pavilion Credentials	\$2/pass	Required for backstage access. Can be supplied by event or may be purchased in advance through Columbus Commons.		
Venue Event Staff	\$22/hour	One Columbus Commons event staff is required per rental location or based on venue needs during setup, event & teardown. 4 hour minimum. Overtime charges may apply.		
Carousel Rental	\$50/half hour	30 minute minimum. 17 figures with 1 ADA chariot.		
Park Restrooms	\$32/hour	Includes ADA accessible women's restrooms (2 stalls) & men's restrooms (1 stall & 1 urinal). Fee applies before & after normal operational hours.		
Perimeter Fencing	Varies	\$300 for 1 rental location. \$500 for full park. Flat fee for setup & teardown of bike-rack barricade fencing (42" high x 90" wide) in approved area. Fencing required for ticketed events or events with alcohol sales.		
Park Security	\$25/hour	Minimum of 1 officer required during events; requirements may increase based on event components. 3 hour minimum.		
Event Electricity	\$30/access	Access & labor fees will be determined by Columbus Commons based on event needs. Separate City electric permit may be required.		
Event Electrical Technician	\$34/hour	Required if Columbus Commons power distribution equipment is utilized. 4 hour minimum.		
Potable Water Access	\$30/day	Access to cold potable water hook up, food grade hose not included.		
Potable Water Connection	\$75/day	If a dedicated connection is needed (e.g. to fill water barrels).		
Parking Vouchers	Varies	Optional: provides free parking in the Columbus Commons Garages. Nonrefundable.		
Park Maintenance	\$32/hour	Minimum staffing level required based on event components. Contracted park trash pick-up of 11 permanent trash cans & housekeeping for 2 permanent restrooms. 4 hour minimum.		
Dumpster Access	\$175/day	(2) 8-yd trash dumpsters & (1) 25-yd recycling dumpster available. Additional dumpsters may need to be rented.		
Trash & Recycling Receptacles	\$5/receptacle	20 receptacles available. Temporary trash & recycling receptacles. Includes setup & teardown. Liners included.		
Tower Lights	\$100/unit	6 units available. Includes setup & teardown. Additional power may be necessary depending on placement.		
Tall Propane Heaters	\$100/unit	4 units available. Includes approximately 6 hours of propane.		
Tent Rental	\$100/10'x10' \$200/10'x20'	(10) 10'x10' & (4) 10'x20' tents available. Includes weights & labor for setup & tear down. Staking is not permitted within the park.		
Tent Weights	\$20/tent	If pop-up-style tents are used in the park, Columbus Commons can provide weights.		
Generator	\$100/unit	(2) 6,500-watt units available. Approximately 6 hours run time.		
Plywood	\$5/piece	Includes rental, setup & teardown. Required to distribute weight & protect surfaces. Additional material may be required to protect surfaces based on		
Alcohol Sales	\$250/day	Required if third-party Temporary Liquor Permit is obtained from Ohio Division of Liquor Control.		
Beverages	Varies	If Columbus Commons bartenders provide service for event, charges will apply afterward.		
Hospitality Water	\$30/case	If Pavilion is used, 2 cases of water will be included. Additional consumption will be charged.		

A deposit is required to reserve your date and will be applied to the total fee. Separate permits may be required for your event (e.g. tent, fire, health, festival, alcohol, and/or street closure permits); it is your responsibility to apply for these permits. Circumstances that require additional staffing will be subject to additional fees.
